



The University Registrar at Nebraska Wesleyan will conduct a course-by-course evaluation of official transcripts to apply courses to general education, academic major, and other degree requirements.

Required coursework can vary based on students' degree program, transferring credit, and other factors. Requirements and transfer equivalencies can change. Ask your NWU admissions counselor for more information.

Courses must have a grade of C- or higher to be eligible for transfer. Courses with numbers below 1000 will not transfer.

A maximum of 64 credit hours can be transferred from community colleges. Students must complete a total of 126 semester hours to earn a bachelor's degree from NWU.
